

# TOUGH LOVE

Tough Love' is a hard-hitting and innovative Applied Theatre project performed by the company 'Alter Ego' that raises awareness of control and abuse in teenage relationships. The play is followed by an actor facilitated post-show talk exploring the issues raised.

'Tough Love' tells the story of 15 year old Becca and her relationship with her violent and controlling boyfriend Danny. How they met, how they fell in love, how the control and violence started and how Becca eventually managed to get help.
