Dear Parent / Carer

Year 8 French Trip – June 2019

After last year's very enjoyable trip, we are planning another five-day residential trip to France in June 2019 for language students in Year 8. The visit will be led by staff at the College and will provide an opportunity for students to take part in educational visits, experiment with the language they have been learning in French classes and experience a different culture from their own. Although this trip is open to all Year 8 students, priority will be given to those students studying French.

Our destination is close to Boulogne. We will stay in a centre which used to be a hotel on the Opal Coast which is owned and run solely by the travel company, Voyager School Travel. There will be French 'animateurs' who will run a range of activities for us in the centre, allowing pupils to listen to and speak French throughout the trip. We will be doing a range of excursions including visits to Boulogne, Le Touquet, Arras, a creperie, a bakery and a goat's cheese farm. Our departure will be early on **Monday 24th June** and we shall return late on **Friday 28th June 2019**.

The cost of the trip will be **£420** per student and payments may be made in instalments. The cost includes transport by coach and ferry, insurance, full board and lodging and the excursions. The only additional cost to parents would be a small amount of pocket money.

Students will need their own passports and EHIC cards. We will look after these during the trip, so will be asking for them a few weeks before our departure. Please be aware that it is your responsibility to ensure that both the passport and EHIC card are in date and that you obtain any visas which may be required for your child to stay in France.

If you would like your child to be considered for a place on the trip, please complete the attached permission slip by Monday 29th October and pay a deposit of £100 via Wisepay. If you have any questions please get back to me at the email address below. If you are having problems logging into Wisepay, or need your log in details re-sent to you, please contact Mrs Smith on ssmith@bassingbournvc.net

Please be aware that places are limited to 50 students and will be 'picked out of a hat' AFTER the closing date, Monday 29th October and NOT on a first come first served basis. There is therefore no pressure to bring the reply slip and pay the deposit on the day that this letter is received. However, priority will be given firstly to those students studying French with any remaining places being allocated to students studying Spanish with names 'picked out of a hat'. If your child is not allocated a place on the trip, the £100 will be refunded via Wisepay.
