## Year 9 - Curriculum Day – 18<sup>th</sup> November 2019

On Monday 18th November Year 9 students will have the opportunity to take part in one of two activities as part of the College's Curriculum Day programme.

The first activity on offer is a trip to the Victoria and Albert Museum in London. The V&A is the world's leading museum of art and design, housing a permanent collection of over 2.3 million objects that span over 5,000 years of human creativity. The Museum holds many of the UK's national collections and houses some of the greatest resources for the study of architecture, furniture, fashion, textiles, photography, sculpture, painting, jewellery, glass, ceramics and theatre performance. The visit will include an opportunity to explore a range of the galleries including The Fashion Gallery and Theatre and Performance Gallery. It is a superb opportunity for anyone studying Textiles, 3D Design, Art & Design or who has an interests in Theatre and Performance or the Arts and is a fabulous opportunity to see art and design from many different cultures.

Students will need to bring a packed lunch and may wish to bring a small amount of money if they wish to buy anything in the gift shop (they sell a large range of postcards which are great for research). The trip will require a contribution of £11.75 which will include coach travel, entry to the museum and entry to either the Mary Quant Fashion exhibition or the Tim Walker Photography exhibition.

Alternatively, the PE team are running a First Aid Day in conjunction with a paramedic and will finish with students having a First Aid Qualification. This day will require a contribution of £3.

Please indicate which activity your son/daughter would like to do and please make the appropriate contribution via the WisePay system by Monday 11<sup>th</sup> November, returning the reply slip below indicating your child's preference. If your child is eligible for pupil premium funding, then there may be financial assistance available. Please contact me if you require assistance from this fund.

The trip to the V&A is limited to 80 students and the First Aid Course to 40 students. In the event of over subscription a draw will take place to determine which activity students will be doing. Students will be informed on Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> November which activity they have been allocated. A code of conduct and parental consent form must be completed if choosing this activity.
